MEDIA (This is just the suggested minimum requirement, you may need other mediums)

- Graphite Pencil: A box of 12 Derwent Graphic Designer Medium Pencils (5B, 3B, 2B, B, H & 3H)
- Charcoal Pencil (no paper-wrapped): soft, medium, hard (6B, 2B & HB) & white (Optional)
- Compressed Charcoal (black) (General's) (Optional)
- Willow Charcoal (soft & medium) (Optional)

KNIFE

- Light-duty Snapoff blades utility knife (Optional)

ERASER

- Kneaded rubber erasers

RULER

- Transparent plastic ruler 12" or longer

View Finder

- 3"x5" white card board with a 1"x1.5" cut out opening (hand-made item)

STUMP & CLOTH

- Stump (Stumps) (Stump: compressed paper, Tortillion: rolled paper, Penpoint, Torchon or Staff); and a small piece of bandage gauze

DRAWING PAPER: (*Strathmore, Canson, Fabriano, Arches* or similar quality paper, acid free & 100% Rag)

- A pad of drawing paper, 400 Series, 14"x17", premium recycled (Optional)
- Better Quality: A pad of drawing paper, Bristol vellum, medium, 80lb, 14"x17", acid free
- Charcoal & Pastel paper, assorted colors, 10"x15", 150g/m (Optional)
- Canson Color charcoal drawing paper, Mil Finte, Dark Gray, Flannel Gray, 19"x25" (Optional)
- Fabriano, 21x29.7cm/8.5"x12", 160gsm/75lbs, 40% cotton (Optional)
- A pad of newsprint, rough surface, 18"x24", 15 sheets (Optional)

SKETCH BOOK

- At least 10"x10" or 11"x14", 50lb or better

DRAWING BOARD WITH CLIPS

- Masonite Board at least 16" x 20"; Better quality: Aero core (Optional)

PLEXIGLAS & MARKER (Optional)

- Plexiglas 1/8", 24"x24" (Optional)
- Red permanent marker (fine point) & Black low odor dry erase marker (Expo 2) (Optional)

WORKABLE FIXATIVE SPRAY (Optional, only on charcoal drawing)
