Hi, Mark. I'm in support of this. What are you proposing to do with the education allowance that comes along with the GAANN? According to the FAQ on line:

The institutional payment must be first applied against a fellow's tuition and fees. After payment of a fellow's tuition and fees, the institutional payment may be applied against educational expenses of the fellow that are not covered by tuition and fees and are related to the academic program in which the fellow is enrolled. These expenses include the following:

1. Costs for rental or purchase of any books, materials, or supplies required of students in the same course of study; and
2. Costs of computer hardware, project-specific software, and other equipment prorated by the length of the student's fellowship over the reasonable life of the equipment.

We'll be happy to provide tuition support beyond the institutional payment. I don't know if this alone will come to the 25% cost sharing.
