On Wednesday (February 1), President Owens will be testifying before the House Appropriations Education Committee regarding funding for higher education, and will be highlighting a number of ways the impending reduction in state funding will effect our university and state.

President Owens would like to speak about open faculty positions that you will not be able to fill if the proposed cut takes place.

Could you please provide some details about your open faculty positions for him to include in his talk?

The kind of information we're looking for is something like, "UMSL was planning to fill two open positions in business, but with the budget cuts, they won't be able to do so." Or, 'The College of Arts and Science has 13 open

positions that probably will not be filled because of the impending cuts in state appropriations."

If you have a list of positions that won't be filled by department or college, that would be great. If you have specific situations of hardship to report, that would be good, also. In other words, please provide information about how the impending cuts will affect your open faculty positions.

We'd like to have something by the end of day so we don't expect it to be highly detailed. We'll work with whatever you can provide.
